100 MARATHON CLUB NORTH AMERICA SUPPORT



Maria Austero-Macavinta of Pleasant Hill, California chose the 2007 Rock 'n Roll Marathon in Phoenix, Arizona for her first marathon. On the way to her 100th she completed 50 states and DC at the 2014 Baystate Marathon in Lowell, Massachusetts. The 2015 Dirty Dozen in San Pablo, California marked Maria's 100th and she is still pounding them out, boosting her current total to 117 marathons and 19 ultras. Her 2016 races include the 100K Pigtails Challenge, the Great Wall Marathon in Beijing, China, and the Inca Trail to Machu Picchu Marathon in Peru. Maria set her 4:27:14 PR in 2014 at age 49.

The 2004 Rock 'n Roll marathon in San Diego, California was the first marathon run by **Bekki Manville** of Colorado Springs, Colorado. Last month's Iceland Marathon held in Reykjavik, Iceland was the location Bekki chose for her 100th marathon. She completed 50 states and DC at the 2013 Kauai Marathon at Poipu Beach, Kauai, Hawaii. Bekki set her 3:26:03 PR in 2013 at age 40. Her current total is 100 marathons and one ultra. Here's Bekki just after finishing her 100th marathon in Iceland →

MEMBER UPDATES




Roger Biggs of Stevenage, England continues the quest for his 900th marathon. Here are postcards Roger sent following two of his recent races:

Monday, July 4, 2016. Sunday was a good day with a marathon from County Town Kirkwall to the small village of Birsay. The Achilles was playing up, but I ran my second best time of the year in 4:41:48. After a quick shower back in Kirkwall, we returned to Birsay for the event Ceiliah! Drinking, dancing, eating (in that order) made for a great evening.

(Editor's note: The information accompanying this postcard mentions "The seventy-plus islands that make up Orkney have...a population of 21,349 (2001 census). Only 10 km at closest from Scotland. Orkney's diverse economy comprises agriculture, fishing, tourism, crafts, whiskey and oil. The mild climate is



due to the North Atlantic Slope Current and Atlantic weather systems. There is much to see and due including world class archaeology, magnificent coastal scenery and wildlife. The World Heritage Site comprises of Maeshowe, the Standing Stones of Stenness, the Ring of Brodgar and Skara Brae dates from 3000 BC, while the Churchill Barriers, Italian Chapel and St. Magnus Cathedral are essential visits.")



Sunday, August 14, 2016. In Ireland for a quad (four marathons in four days) in Donegal. With ongoing injuries, I was pleased to manage #1 and #4. In Canada soon, so watch out for more postcards.

(Another Editor's note from the information accompanying this postcard: "The Wild Atlantic Way is the world's longest defined coastal touring route stretching 2,500 km along Ireland's wild Atlantic coast from Donegal to West Cork.")
