100 MARATHON CLUB NORTH AMERICA SUPPORT

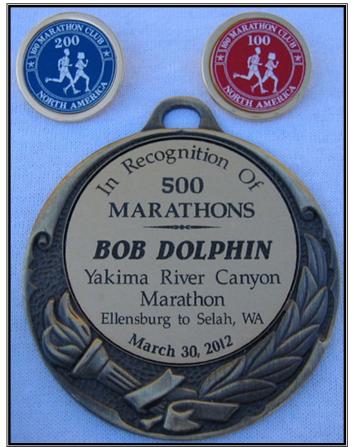

Last month's Des Moines Marathon in Des Moines, Iowa marked his milestone 100th marathon. Paul completed 50 states and DC at the 2014 Grand Rapids Marathon in Grand Rapids, Michigan. He established his 3:29:18 PR on his 47th birthday in 2005, and matched his PR time again in 2013 at age 55. Paul's current total includes 100 marathons and two ultras. He is a member of the Capital Striders Running Club in Des Moines.
